TYPES OF e-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

	Synchronous	Asynchronous
Definition	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Happens in <u>real time</u>.-ie Students and instructor interact in a specific virtual place, through a specific online medium, at a specific time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning occurs through online channels <u>without real-time interaction</u>.-ie materials and assignments can be completed within the given time-frame
Examples of activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Video conferencing• Teleconferencing• Live chatting• Live-streaming lectures	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Self-guided lesson modules• Streaming video content• Virtual libraries• Posted lecture notes• Exchanges across discussion boards or social media platforms



TYPES OF e-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

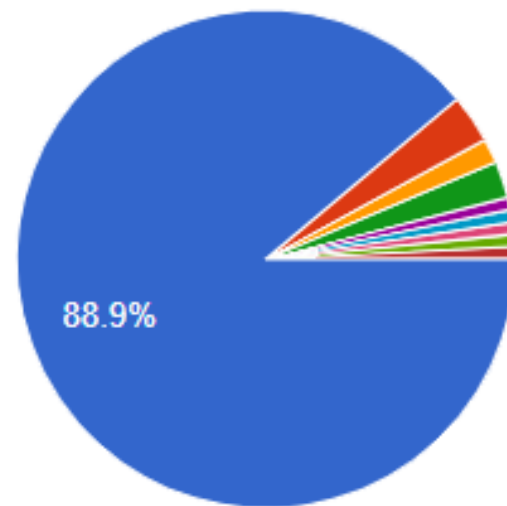
	Synchronous	Asynchronous
Advantages	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classroom engagement• Dynamic learning• Instructional depth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flexibility• Pacing
Disadvantages	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rigid schedule• Technical difficulties	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Risk of ineffectiveness• Risk of apathy (lack of enthusiasm/interest)

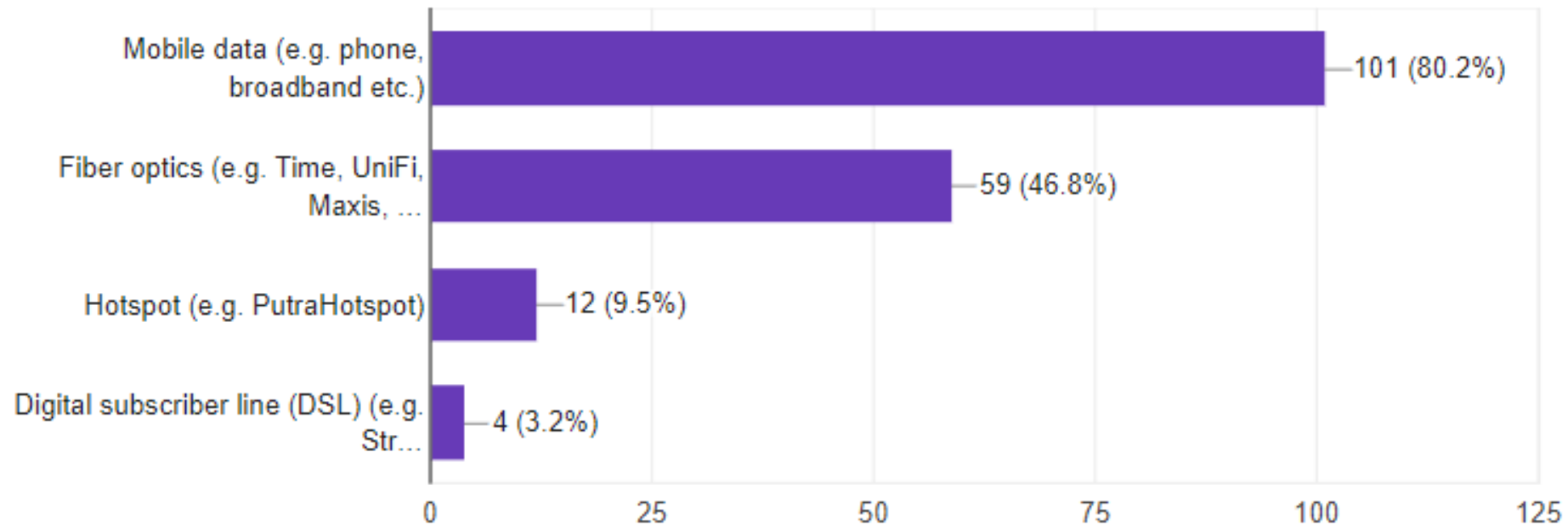

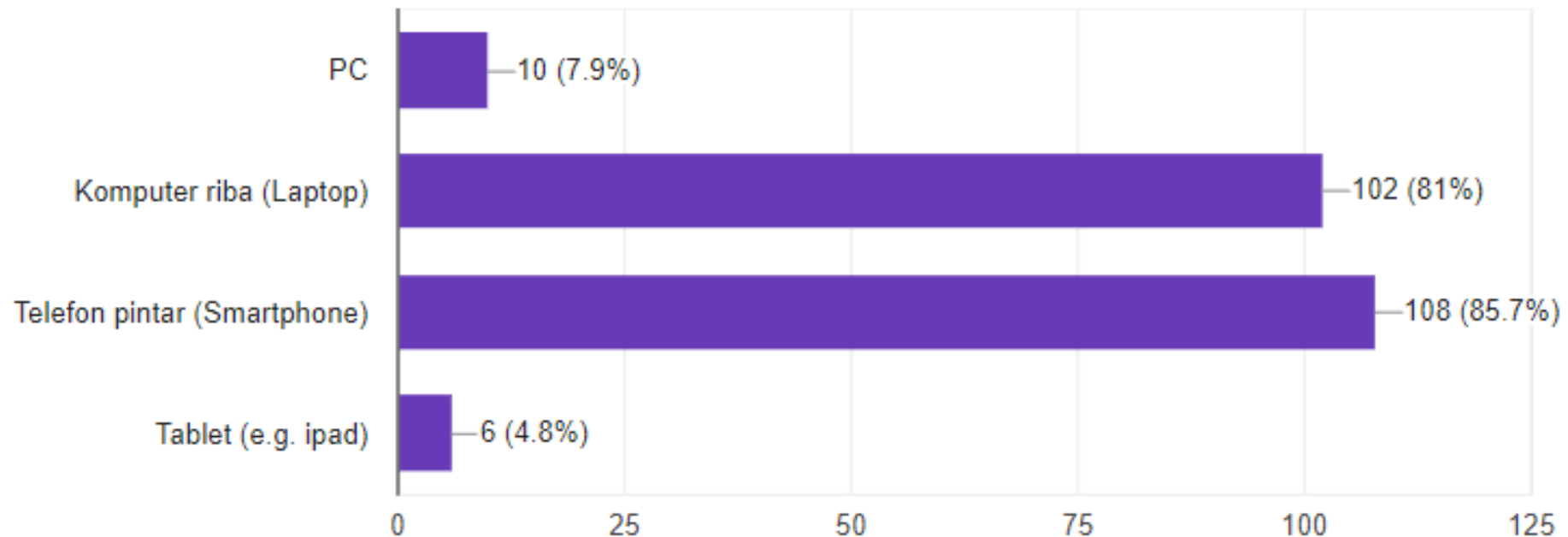

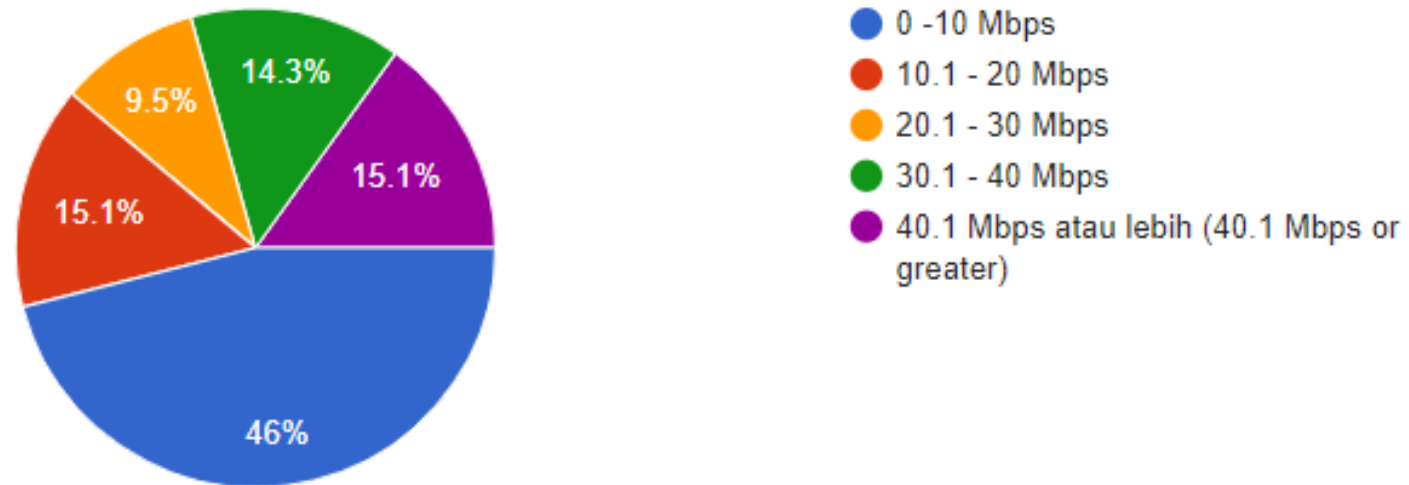

Part 3: Publishing Your Own Video

- A default setting which allows everyone to see the video you post.



- Does not appear in the search results, suggestions or video tab.
- Can be shared with the people you wish to share and the users having a link to the video can see it.
- Can also be viewed by the friend of friends if they share the link with their friends.

- Does not appear in the recommendations, search options in YouTube or in your tab.
- Can be seen only by the uploader and the mentioned Google accounts.
- If your friend shares it with someone, it won't be visible to others.
- If anyone wishes to view a private video, the person has to request permission to view to the uploader.

Part 3: Publishing Your Own Video

- Other free video hosting sites: Vimeo, Facebook, etc
- Sharing alternative: Cloud storage – eg: Google Drive, One Drive
- Issue: **If it is viewable, it is downloadable**



Part 4: Utilizing H5P for Effective Teaching and Learning Videos



1. Interactive video

- Allowing users to add multiple choice and fill in the blank questions, pop-up text and other types of interactions to their videos using only a web browser

2. Quiz (Question set)

- Can be designed to facilitate learners' understanding on the published video
- Allows the learner to solve a sequence of various question types.
- You can combine many different question types like Multichoice, Drag and Drop and Fill in the blanks in a Question set.
